1. Types of Test

Eligibility	 Patients with solid tumors for which there is no standard treatment. Patients with solid tumors who have been diagnosed with locally advanced or metastatic cancer and have completed standard treatment or are expected to complete treatment. Patients who, based on their overall physical condition, organ function, and other factors, are determined by their attending physician to have a high likelihood of being eligible for chemotherapy after undergoing this test, in accordance with guidelines on chemotherapy from relevant academic societies, etc. For FoundationOne® Liquid CDx Cancer Genomic Profiling, in addition to the above, patients who fall into one of the following categories. Patients who do not have a solid tumor specimen or find it difficult to prepare one. Patients who did not obtain clear results of CGP Tests performed on tumor cell specimens collected from solid tumors. 		



2. CGP Tests Clinic

- CGP Test requires an appointment.
- The first visit for CGP Tests (as a second opinion) costs \(\frac{\pma}{4}4,000\) (incl. tax). There is a separate inspection fee for CGP tests.
- Patients are required to come to the hospital themselves for the tests.
- You are required to visit CGP Tests Clinic three times: (1) to receive an explanation of the test, (2) to submit your application, and (3) to receive an explanation of the results.
- Patients should be accompanied by someone, especially for the first visit, as important matters will be explained regarding the test.



We will ask you about your family structure at the first visit.

Please bring information regarding your family members, starting from grandparents to grandchildren, as well as details about their diseases and the year of onset.

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3. Payment for CGP Tests

Payment can also be made by credit card.

(1) CGP Tests Covered by National Health Insurance

In order for National Health Insurance to cover the cost of the test, the patient must receive an explanation of the test results in person at our hospital's outpatient department (an explanation of test results cannot be provided while confined at a different hospital).

CGP Tests Covered by National Health Insurance

The cost of treatment following tests, such as medication, is not included in the cost of the test.
